1 HISTORIC POT HOUSE MILE MARKER 10.5

At the corner of Mountville and Foxcroft roads sits the historic Pot House where craftsmen once kilned bricks and forged iron. Nowadays, it is a charming Airbnb and you can also often find a delightful self-serve flower stand out front - take a bunch and leave some payment.

2 ROKEBY MILE MARKER 20.7

Rokeby was established in the 1940s by American philanthropist and owner/breeder of thoroughbred racehorses, Paul Mellon. Over time, the farm grew to encompass over 3600 stunning acres and was home to many champion racehorses over the years, including 1993 Kentucky Derby winner Sea Hero.

3 UPPERVILLE MILE MARKER 45.1

Upperville. Blink and you could miss it. Founded in the 1790s, the tiny hamlet was immortalized in a John Updike poem, and is fondly referred to as "the town that's an inch wide and a mile long." It has some of the most scenic countryside around and boasts restaurants and several sites of historic importance for the civil war buffs.

4 MOUNTAIN VIEWS MILE MARKER 60.0

It is the rolling fields and stone walls, set against the aptly named Blue Ridge mountains, that help Middleburg earn its Horse & Hunt Country capital moniker. Many from the hunt field still gather near this iconic view to ride on fall weekends and it is a perfect spot to view spectacular sunsets, particularly this time of year.

5 TOWN OF MIDDLEBURG MILE MARKER 64.2

Your rally ends at the stop light & Red Fox Inn & Tavern in Middleburg. The town was so named because it was the halfway point between Alexandria and Winchester along the popular Ashby Gap trading route, better known today as Route 50. The historic Red Fox has presided over the center of town since 1728 and is the oldest continuously operating inn in America. Parking available at the Middleburg Elementary School.
